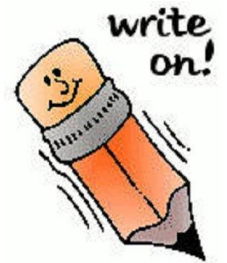

Literacy

This term we are going to study two books. The first is called 'Farther', it is wonderful story about a father that wants to be able to fly. Our second book is entitled 'Until I Met Dudley'. At first this book describes how a child thinks something works and then Dudley explains how it really works. We will continue to work hard on developing both our handwriting and using expanded noun phrases in our work. We will also be improving our spelling. Our Spellings are linked to each story that we read and some are quite challenging. As a class we try to come up with rhymes or sayings to help us remember how to spell certain words.



Maths

We will be continuing to explore addition and subtraction, measurement- area and multiplication and division this half term. We will also try and solve more difficult maths puzzles and problems using our problem solving and reasoning skills. We will be working very hard on learning our times table and I would be very grateful if you could help your child with this task in preparation for the government's summer multiplication test. The children enjoy using j2Blast and we are going to be using White Rose Maths 1-Minute Maths app.



Science

This half term we will continue to look at the human digestive system. We have been naming and learning about the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive

system. This half term we will focus on construction and interpreting food chains. The children will be taking part in a variety of experiments!

RE

This half term we will be answering the question 'What do Hindus believe that God is like?'. We will learn about the range of 'Aum' symbols and what they mean. In class we will be learning about the story of Svetaketu and finding out about what happens at an act of puja at home.

Geography

We will be looking at biomes. We will be learning to name and locate different biomes and their climates. We will learn about the different animals that live in certain biomes.

Physical Education

We will be doing P.E. on a Wednesday and Friday this term so please ensure that your child wears the appropriate P.E. kit on those days.
