COVID Catch Up Funding

The Government have allocated Catch Up funding to schools based on the number of children in the school. This is intended to be used to help children to catch up with learning missed during the first period of lockdown.

At Spittal Community First School we are:-

- Employing a teacher for 2 afternoons per week. This is to release existing staff to work in small groups with children with identified needs in Key Stage 1.
- Employing a teacher to release existing staff to work in small groups with children with identified needs in Key Stage 2.

We are measuring the number of children currently working below the programme of study for their year group. By the end of the year we will be able to see the impact of this expenditure in terms of children working within their year group curriculum.
